CALCULATION OF STUDENT ATTENDANCE ΙN EVALUATING SCHOOL PERFORMANCE. (a) The commissioner by rule shall 10 develop and adopt a process for a school district to apply to the 11 agency for an exemption from having an absence of a student with a 12 chronic or debilitating illness or condition that is attributable 13 14 to the student's illness or condition be included in the calculation of student attendance for purposes of the achievement 15 16 indicator under Section 39.053(c)(4)(B)(i). (b) To apply for the exemption a school district must obtain 17 documentation from a physician indicating that: 18 19 (1) the student is a patient of the physician; (2) the student has <u>a chronic or debilitating illness</u> 20 or condition; and 21 22 (3) the absence for which the exemption is sought is 23 attributable to the student's illness or condition. 24 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018

2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
