## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the time for holding certain runoff elections.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Sections 2.025(c) and (d), Election Code, are 5 amended to read as follows:

6 (c) This section supersedes a law outside this <u>code</u>
7 [<del>subchapter</del>] to the extent of <u>any</u> [<del>a</del>] conflict notwithstanding
8 Section 2.022.

9 (d) Except as otherwise provided by this code, a [A] runoff 10 election for a special election to fill a vacancy in Congress or a 11 special election to fill a vacancy in the legislature [to which 12 Section 101.104 applies] shall be held not earlier than the 70th day 13 or later than the <u>84th</u> [77th] day after the date the final canvass 14 of the main election is completed.

15 SECTION 2. Section 203.004(b), Election Code, is amended to 16 read as follows:

(b) If the election is to be held as an emergency election, it shall be held on a Tuesday or Saturday occurring on or after the 36th day and before the 50th day after the date the election is ordered. <u>Any necessary runoff election must be held on a Tuesday or</u> <u>Saturday occurring not earlier than the 20th day or later than the</u> <u>45th day after the date the final canvass of the main election is</u> <u>completed.</u>

SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only

1 to an election ordered on or after the effective date of this Act.
2 An election ordered before the effective date of this Act is
3 governed by the law in effect when the election was ordered, and the
4 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
