1 AN ACT 2 relating to prohibiting the court-martial of a member of the state military forces on the basis of the member's report of a sexual 3 assault. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter J, Chapter 432, Government Code, is 7 amended by adding Section 432.1211 to read as follows: Sec. 432.1211. REPORT OF SEXUAL ASSAULT. A person subject 8 9 to this chapter may not be held for trial by court-martial or punished under this chapter for an offense based solely on the 10 person's conduct of filing a report as a victim of or witness to an 11 incident of sexual assault. 12 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to an 13 14 offense under Chapter 432, Government Code, committed before, on, or after the effective date of this Act, except that a final 15 16 conviction for an offense under Chapter 432, Government Code, that exists on the effective date of this Act is unaffected by this Act. 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 20
