1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to designating July 7 as Fallen Law Enforcement Officer
1-18 Day.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 662, Government Code, is
1-21 amended by adding Section 662.066 to read as follows:

1-22 Sec. 662.066. FALLEN LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER DAY. (a) July
1-23 7 is Fallen Law Enforcement Officer Day in recognition of the
1-24 ultimate sacrifice made by Texas law enforcement officers killed in
1-25 the line of duty.

1-26 (b) Fallen Law Enforcement Officer Day shall be regularly
1-27 observed by appropriate ceremonies.

1-28 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-29 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-30 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-31 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-32 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
