## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 1301.354, Occupations Code, is amended
- 7 by adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows:
- 8 (c-1) At the applicant's request, the board may credit an
- 9 applicant under Subsection (b) with up to 250 hours of the work
- 10 experience required before taking an examination if the applicant
- 11 has completed a coherent sequence of courses in the construction
- 12 trade that are offered through a career and technical education
- 13 program that is approved by the State Board of Education.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
