## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to certain benefits and protections for service members of 3 the Texas military forces ordered to state active duty or to state 4 training and other duty.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 SECTION 1. Section 437.213, Government Code, is amended

6 SECTION 1. Section 437.213, Government Code, is amended to 7 read as follows:

8 Sec. 437.213. CERTAIN BENEFITS AND PROTECTIONS FOR STATE 9 SERVICE. A service member of the Texas military forces who is 10 ordered to state active duty or to state training and other duty by 11 the governor, the adjutant general, or another proper authority 12 under the law of this state is entitled to the same benefits and 13 protections provided to persons:

(1) performing service in the uniformed services as provided by 38 U.S.C. Sections 4301-4313 and 4316-4319[<del>, as that</del> <del>law existed on April 1, 2003</del>]; and

17 (2) in the military service of the United States as
18 provided by 50 [App.] U.S.C. Sections <u>3901-3959</u>, <u>3991</u>, and
19 <u>4011-4026</u> [501-536, 560, and 580-594, as that law existed on April
20 1, 2003].

21 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 22 to a service member of the Texas military forces who is serving on 23 state active duty or on state training and other duty on the 24 effective date of this Act or who is ordered to such duty on or after

1 that date.

2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
