A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to compensation to be paid to an emergency services 3 district for a municipality's annexation of the district's 4 territory.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 775.022(e), Health and Safety Code, is 7 amended to read as follows:

8 (e) The amount of compensation under Subsection (c) shall be 9 determined by multiplying the district's total indebtedness at the 10 time of the annexation by a fraction:

11 (1) the numerator of which is the assessed value of the 12 property to be annexed based on the most recent certified county 13 property tax rolls at the time of annexation <u>plus the total amount</u> 14 <u>of the district's sales and use tax revenue collected by retailers</u> 15 <u>located in the property to be annexed in the 12 months preceding the</u> 16 <u>date of annexation, as reported by the comptroller;</u> and

17 (2) the denominator of which is the total assessed 18 value of the property of the district based on the most recent 19 certified county property tax rolls at the time of annexation <u>plus</u> 20 <u>the total amount of the district's sales and use tax revenue</u> 21 <u>collected by retailers located in the district in the 12 months</u> 22 <u>preceding the date of annexation, as reported by the comptroller</u>.

23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
