Subchapter B, Chapter 1704, Occupations Code, is 5 amended by adding Section 1704.0531 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 1704.0531. BOARD COMPOSITION IN CERTAIN COUNTIES. (a) This section applies only in a county with a population of 700,000 7 or more but less than 780,000. 8 9 (b) A board in a county described by Subsection (a) consists 10 of nine members as follows: 11 (1) a licensed bail bond surety or agent for a 12 corporate surety in the county; (2) two criminal defense attorneys practicing in the 13 14 county; 15 (3) the county judge; 16 (4) the county clerk; (5) the district clerk; 17 (6) a justice of the peace; 18 19 (7) the sheriff or a designee from the sheriff's 20 office; and 21 (8) a judge of a district or county court having jurisdiction over criminal matters in the county. 22 23 (c) The members described by Subsections (b)(1), (2), and (6) shall be elected as provided by Section 1704.0535. Each judge 24

1 of a district or county court having criminal jurisdiction in the 2 county is entitled to cast one vote at a secret ballot election 3 conducted by the board annually to elect the board member described by Subsection (b)(8). 4 5 (d) The board shall elect a presiding officer from its members to serve a one-year term. A member may not serve more than 6 7 two consecutive terms as presiding officer. 8 (e) The provisions of Chapter 551, Government Code, apply to the board. 9 10 (f) The board shall prepare and maintain minutes of each board meeting. 11 12 (g) A board member who has a substantial interest in a business entity, as determined by Section 171.002, Local Government 13 14 Code, must file, before a vote or decision on any matter involving 15 the business entity, an affidavit stating the nature and extent of the interest and shall abstain from further participation in the 16 17 matter. SECTION 2. On the effective date of this Act, the term of a 18 member of an existing bail bond board in a county to which Section 19 1704.0531, Occupations Code, as added by this Act, applies, who is 20 21 not a member of the board established under that section, is terminated. 2.2
