A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the definitions of highway maintenance and service
3	vehicles for purposes of certain provisions governing vehicle
4	equipment.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 547.001, Transportation Code, is amended
7	by adding Subdivisions (2-b) and (6-a) to read as follows:
8	(2-b) "Highway maintenance vehicle" means a highway or
9	traffic maintenance vehicle designated by the Texas Department of
10	Transportation. The term includes equipment for:
11	(A) road maintenance, including:
12	(i) equipment for snow removal, line
13	striping, skid resistance testing, sweeping, and spraying;
14	(ii) aerial devices; and
15	(iii) high-speed profilometers; and
16	(B) off-road use, including motor graders, road
17	rollers, excavators, pneumatic tire equipment, movers, and
18	tractors.
19	(6-a) "Service vehicle" means a highway or traffic
20	<pre>maintenance vehicle that:</pre>
21	(A) is owned and operated on a highway by or for a
22	governmental agency and performs a function requiring the use of a
23	lamp or illuminating device in accordance with the standards and
24	specifications adopted under Section 547 105. or

- 1 (B) has a public service function, including
- 2 public utility vehicles, tow trucks, and any vehicle designated as
- 3 a service vehicle by the Texas Department of Transportation or as an
- 4 escort flag vehicle under Section 623.099.
- 5 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 547.105, Transportation
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 547.105. MAINTENANCE AND SERVICE <u>VEHICLE</u> [EQUIPMENT]
- 8 LIGHTING STANDARDS.
- 9 SECTION 3. Sections 547.105(a) and (b), Transportation
- 10 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 11 (a) The Texas Department of Transportation shall adopt
- 12 standards and specifications that:
- 13 (1) apply to lamps on highway maintenance and service
- 14 vehicles [equipment, including snow-removal equipment]; and
- 15 (2) correlate with and conform as closely as possible
- 16 to standards and specifications approved by the American
- 17 Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials.
- 18 (b) The Texas Department of Transportation may adopt
- 19 standards and specifications for lighting that permit the use of
- 20 flashing lights for identification purposes on highway maintenance
- 21 and service <u>vehicles</u> [equipment, including snow-removal
- 22 equipment].
- SECTION 4. Section 547.305(e), Transportation Code, is
- 24 amended to read as follows:
- (e) A person may not operate \underline{a} highway maintenance or
- 26 service vehicle [equipment, including snow-removal equipment,]
- 27 that is not equipped with lamps or that does not display lighted

- 1 lamps as required by the standards and specifications adopted by
- 2 the Texas Department of Transportation.
- 3 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
