- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 264, Family Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 264.2012 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 264.2012. FAMILY PRESERVATION SERVICES. In the five
- 9 areas of the state that have the highest number of high-risk
- 10 families determined by zip code, the department shall implement an
- 11 evidence-based program that provides frequent in-home visits with
- 12 <u>families who have a history of child abuse or neglect or who display</u>
- 13 risk factors for child abuse or neglect with the goal of improving
- 14 family preservation and family reunification. The program must
- 15 contain guidelines for the frequency of monthly contact by the
- 16 department with the family, based on the risk factors for child
- 17 <u>abuse and neglect in each case.</u>
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
