- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- SECTION 1. Section 11.38(d), Alcoholic Beverage Code, is 5
- amended to read as follows: 6
- 7 The following are exempt from the fee authorized in this
- section: 8
- 9 (1)agent's, airline beverage, passenger
- 10 beverage, passenger bus beverage, industrial, carrier's, private
- carrier's, private club registration, local cartage, storage, and 11
- 12 temporary wine and beer retailer's permits;
- 13 (2) a wine and beer retailer's permit issued for a
- dining, buffet, or club car; and 14
- (3) a mixed beverage permit during the three-year 15
- 16 period following the issuance of the permit.
- SECTION 2. Subtitle A, Title 3, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is 17
- amended by adding Chapter 48A to read as follows: 18
- CHAPTER 48A. PASSENGER BUS BEVERAGE PERMIT 19
- 20 Sec. 48A.01. AUTHORIZED ACTIVITIES; APPLICABILITY
- CHAPTER. (a) The holder of a passenger bus beverage permit has the 21
- same rights with respect to the sale of alcoholic beverages on a 22
- 23 passenger bus, described by Subsection (b), as the holder of an
- airline beverage permit has with respect to the sale of alcoholic 24

- 1 beverages on a commercial passenger airplane under Section 34.01.
- 2 (b) Subsection (a) applies only to a passenger bus that:
- 3 (1) is designed, constructed, or used for the
- 4 transportation of multiple passengers for compensation; and
- 5 (2) while transporting persons for compensation, also
- 6 transports an attendant who:
- 7 (A) is not the operator of the bus; and
- 8 (B) has attended a commission-approved seller
- 9 training program.
- Sec. 48A.02. FEE. The annual fee for a passenger bus
- 11 beverage permit is \$500.
- 12 Sec. 48A.03. ELIGIBILITY FOR PERMIT. The commission or
- 13 <u>administrator may issue a passenger bus beverage permit to any</u>
- 14 corporation operating a commercial passenger bus service in or
- 15 through the state. Application and payment of the fee shall be made
- 16 <u>directly to the commission.</u>
- 17 Sec. 48A.04. EXEMPTION FROM TAXES. The preparation and
- 18 <u>service of alcoholic beverages by the holder of a passenger bus</u>
- 19 beverage permit is exempt from a tax imposed by this code and from
- 20 the tax imposed by Chapter 151, Tax Code.
- 21 Sec. 48A.05. INAPPLICABLE PROVISION. Section 109.53 does
- 22 not apply to a passenger bus beverage permit.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
