9	FOR CERTAIN EDUCATORS AND CHILD-CARE PROVIDERS. (a) The council
10	shall develop wellness guidelines to educate public school
11	teachers, public school administrators, and licensed child-care
12	providers about serving as role models for children by:
13	(1) practicing healthy nutrition; and
14	(2) engaging in physical activity.
15	(b) The council shall develop incentives to encourage
16	public school teachers, public school administrators, and licensed
17	child-care providers to follow the guidelines.

- 22 SECTION 2. The interagency obesity council shall develop

- 1 January 1, 2018. The council shall communicate the guidelines and
- 2 incentives as required by Section 114.009(c), Health and Safety
- 3 Code, as added by this Act, not later than July 1, 2018.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
