5	SECTION 1. Section 2004.002, Occupations Code, is amended
6	by adding Subdivision (1-a) and amending Subdivision (2) to read as
7	follows:
8	(1-a) "Debit card" has the meaning assigned by Section
9	32.31, Penal Code.
10	(2) "Professional sports team" means <u>:</u>
11	(A) a team organized in this state that is a
12	member of Major League Baseball, the National Basketball
13	Association, the National Hockey League, the National Football
14	League, [or] Major League Soccer <u>, the American Hockey League, the</u>
15	East Coast Hockey League, the American Association of Independent
16	Professional Baseball, the Atlantic League of Professional
17	Baseball, Minor League Baseball, the National Basketball
18	Association Development League, the National Women's Soccer
19	League, the Major Arena Soccer League, the United Soccer League, or
20	the Women's National Basketball Association;
21	(B) a person hosting a motorsports racing team
22	event sanctioned by the National Association for Stock Car Auto
23	Racing (NASCAR), INDYCar, or another nationally recognized

1 permanent seating capacity of not less than 75,000; or

(C) an organization hosting a Professional Golf

3 Association event.

4 SECTION 2. Section 2004.009(a), Occupations Code, is 5 amended to read as follows:

6 (a) A person commits an offense if the person accepts any 7 form of payment other than United States currency <u>or a debit card</u> 8 for the purchase of a raffle ticket for a charitable raffle 9 conducted under this chapter.

10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on December 1, 2017, but 11 only if the constitutional amendment proposed by the 85th 12 Legislature, Regular Session, 2017, to authorize additional 13 professional sports team charitable foundations to conduct 14 charitable raffles at additional venues is approved by the voters. 15 If that amendment is not approved by the voters, this Act has no 16 effect.
