2 SECTION 2. Section 2004.009(a), Occupations Code, is 3 amended to read as follows:

4 (a) A person commits an offense if the person accepts any
5 form of payment other than United States currency <u>or a debit card</u>
6 for the purchase of a raffle ticket for a charitable raffle
7 conducted under this chapter.

8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on December 1, 2017, but 9 only if the constitutional amendment proposed by the 85th 10 Legislature, Regular Session, 2017, to authorize additional 11 professional sports team charitable foundations to conduct 12 charitable raffles at additional venues is approved by the voters. 13 If that amendment is not approved by the voters, this Act has no 14 effect.
