## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the accommodation of a deaf or hard of hearing student
3	in driver education; authorizing a fee.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 1001, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 1001.059 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 1001.059. DEPARTMENT DRIVER EDUCATION COURSE FOR DEAF
8	OR HARD OF HEARING STUDENTS. (a) The department shall:
9	(1) create, in cooperation with another state agency
10	if necessary, a driver education course for minors and adults that
11	presents the course curriculum in American Sign Language; and
12	(2) make the course described by Subdivision (1)
13	available on the department's Internet website.
14	(b) The commission by rule shall establish a fee for the
15	course. The fee established under this section:
16	(1) is in addition to a fee charged for a certificate
17	for the course; and
18	(2) must be in an amount that is:
19	(A) sufficient to cover the cost of creating and
20	administering the course; and
21	(B) not more than the average cost of an online
22	driver education course provided in this state, as determined by
23	the commission.
24	SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 1001, Education Code, is

- 1 amended by adding Section 1001.1016 to read as follows:
- 2 Sec. 1001.1016. ACCOMMODATION FOR DEAF OR HARD OF HEARING
- 3 STUDENTS. (a) In this section:
- 4 (1) "Deaf" means a hearing loss of such severity that
- 5 an individual must depend on visual methods to communicate.
- 6 (2) "Hard of hearing" means a loss of hearing function
- 7 to an individual such that the individual:
- 8 (A) relies on residual hearing; and
- 9 (B) may depend on visual methods to communicate.
- 10 (b) The commission by rule shall require a driver education
- 11 school providing a driver education course to:
- 12 (1) in the manner described by the Americans with
- 13 Disabilities Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. Section 12101 et seq.), make
- 14 reasonable modifications and provide aids and services that are
- 15 necessary to ensure that a student who is deaf or hard of hearing
- 16 may fully participate in the course; and
- 17 (2) provide to the department the school's plan for
- 18 complying with the rules adopted under this section as a condition
- 19 of obtaining a license under Section 1001.211 or renewing a license
- 20 under Section 1001.303.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
