A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to a requirement that a public institution of higher
- 3 education include a disciplinary notation on a student's transcript
- 4 under certain circumstances.

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 51.9364 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 51.9364. CERTAIN DISCIPLINARY NOTATIONS REQUIRED ON
- 9 STUDENT TRANSCRIPTS. (a) In this section, "institution of higher
- 10 education" has the meaning assigned by Section 61.003.
- 11 (b) If an institution of higher education suspends or expels
- 12 <u>a student from the institution for any reason, the institution</u>
- 13 shall include on the student's transcript a disciplinary notation
- 14 stating that the student was suspended or expelled, as applicable,
- 15 from the institution.
- 16 (c) If a student withdraws from an institution of higher
- 17 education pending disciplinary charges that may have resulted in
- 18 the student's suspension or expulsion from the institution if the
- 19 student had not withdrawn, the institution may not end the
- 20 disciplinary process until the institution makes a final
- 21 determination of responsibility, including, if applicable, a
- 22 <u>determination of whether the student would have been suspended or</u>
- 23 <u>expelled from the institution as a result. If the institution</u>
- 24 determines that the student would have been suspended or expelled

- 1 from the institution, the institution shall include a disciplinary
- 2 notation on the student's transcript stating that the student would
- 3 have been suspended or expelled, as applicable, from the
- 4 institution if the student had not withdrawn.
- 5 (d) An institution of higher education shall remove from a
- 6 student's transcript a disciplinary notation indicating the
- 7 student's suspension from the institution if the institution
- 8 determines that each condition of the suspension has been
- 9 fulfilled. A suspended student may file a petition with the
- 10 institution requesting removal of the disciplinary notation under
- 11 <u>this subsection.</u>
- 12 (e) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall
- 13 adopt rules as necessary to implement this section, including rules
- 14 establishing a process for a student to appeal or petition for the
- 15 removal of a disciplinary notation under this section.
- 16 SECTION 2. The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board
- 17 shall adopt the rules required by Section 51.9364, Education Code,
- 18 as added by this Act, as soon as practicable after this Act takes
- 19 effect.
- 20 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies
- 21 beginning with the 2017 fall semester.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
