- 8 REQUIREMENT. (a) In this section:
- 9 (1) "General academic teaching institution" and
- 10 "public state college" have the meanings assigned by Section

- 12 (2) "Mental health professional" has the meaning
- 13 <u>assigned by Section 164.003, Health and Safety Code.</u>
- 14 (b) This section applies only to a general academic teaching
- 15 institution other than a public state college.
- 16 (c) Beginning with the 2021-2022 academic year, an
- 17 institution to which this section applies shall ensure that at
- 18 least one full-time mental health professional is available at the
- 19 <u>institution for every 1,500 students enrolled in a full course load</u>
- 20 at the institution.
- 21 (c-1) Beginning with the 2018-2019 academic year, an
- 22 <u>institution to which this section applies shall ensure that at</u>
- 23 least one full-time mental health professional is available at the
- 24 institution for every 1,750 students enrolled in a full course load

- 2 (d) The mental health professional to student ratio
- 3 required by this section does not include students who attend the
- 4 <u>institution through online coursework only.</u>
- 5 (e) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall
- 6 adopt rules as necessary to administer this section.
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
