## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to demonstration projects to coordinate eligibility
- 3 renewal and eligibility recertification for certain children in the
- 4 Medicaid and child health plan programs.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 62, Health and Safety
- 7 Code, is amended by adding Section 62.1025 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 62.1025. ELIGIBILITY RENEWAL DEMONSTRATION PROJECT.
- 9 (a) The commission shall establish a demonstration project through
- 10 the child health plan program to allow the commission to
- 11 simultaneously renew the eligibility of multiple children within
- 12 the same household who are eligible for enrollment in the program.
- 13 (b) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules necessary
- 14 to determine the scope of, and eligibility for participating in,
- 15 the demonstration project.
- 16 (c) The commission shall operate the demonstration project
- 17 under this section in conjunction with the demonstration project
- 18 under Section 32.02614, Human Resources Code, if feasible.
- 19 (d) Not later than December 1, 2020, the commission shall
- 20 submit a report to the legislature regarding the commission's
- 21 progress in establishing and operating the demonstration project
- 22 and recommendations on continuing or expanding the demonstration
- 23 project.

(e) This section expires September 1, 2021.

- 1 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 32, Human Resources Code,
- 2 is amended by adding Section 32.02614 to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 32.02614. ELIGIBILITY RECERTIFICATION DEMONSTRATION
- 4 PROJECT. (a) The commission shall establish a demonstration
- 5 project through the medical assistance program to allow the
- 6 commission to simultaneously recertify the eligibility of multiple
- 7 children within the same household who are eligible for medical
- 8 assistance under this chapter.
- 9 (b) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules necessary
- 10 to determine the scope of, and eligibility for participating in,
- 11 the demonstration project.
- 12 <u>(c) The commission shall operate the demonstration project</u>
- 13 under this section in conjunction with the demonstration project
- 14 under Section 62.1025, Health and Safety Code, if feasible.
- 15 (d) Not later than December 1, 2020, the commission shall
- 16 submit a report to the legislature regarding the commission's
- 17 progress in establishing and operating the demonstration project
- 18 and recommendations on continuing or expanding the demonstration
- 19 project.
- 20 (e) This section expires September 1, 2021.
- 21 SECTION 3. Not later than September 1, 2018, the Health and
- 22 Human Services Commission shall implement the eligibility renewal
- 23 and eligibility recertification demonstration projects required by
- 24 Section 62.1025, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, and
- 25 Section 32.02614, Human Resources Code, as added by this Act.
- SECTION 4. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 27 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a

- 1 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 2 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 3 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 4 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 5 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
