A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to creation, attachment, perfection, and enforcement of
- 3 certain liens in the slaughtering of livestock.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 148.026, Agriculture Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (b) Notwithstanding Chapter 9, Business & Commerce Code, or
- 9 any other law, a [A] lien under this section is attached and
- 10 perfected on delivery of the livestock to the purchaser without
- 11 further action, including the filing of a financial statement. The
- 12 lien continues as to the animal, its carcass, its products, and the
- 13 proceeds of any sale without regard to possession by the party
- 14 entitled to the lien.
- (c) A provision of this section that relates to the
- 16 creation, attachment, perfection, or enforcement of a lien controls
- 17 to the extent of a conflict with Chapter 9, Business & Commerce
- 18 Code, or other applicable law.
- 19 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 148.026, Agriculture
- 20 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 21 Sec. 148.026. SELLER'S LIEN.
- SECTION 3. Section 148.027(a), Agriculture Code, is amended
- 23 to read as follows:
- 24 (a) If an animal, its carcass, or its products is under a

- 1 lien <u>under Section 148.026</u> and is commingled with other livestock,
- 2 carcasses, or products so that the identity is lost, the lien
- 3 extends to all of the commingled animals, carcasses, or products as
- 4 if the lien had been perfected originally in all of them.
- 5 SECTION 4. Section 148.028, Agriculture Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 148.028. PRIORITY OF SELLER'S LIEN. (a) Except as
- 8 provided by Subsection (b), a [A] lien under Section 148.026 [this
- 9 subchapter] has priority over any other lien or perfected security
- 10 interest in the animal, its carcass, its products, or proceeds from
- 11 the sale of the animal, its carcass, or its products.
- 12 (b) A lien under Section 148.031 on an animal, its carcass,
- 13 its products, or any proceeds from the disposition of the animal,
- 14 its carcass, or its products has priority over a lien under Section
- 15 <u>148.026.</u>
- SECTION 5. Subchapter C, Chapter 148, Agriculture Code, is
- 17 amended by adding Section 148.031 to read as follows:
- 18 <u>Sec. 148.031. TERMINAL LIVESTOCK FEEDING FACILITY LIEN.</u>
- 19 (a) In this section, "terminal livestock feeding facility" means a
- 20 facility that provides feeding and care to livestock that are left
- 21 with the facility for preparation for slaughter.
- (b) To secure the payment of the charges for the services
- 23 provided by a terminal livestock feeding facility, the facility has
- 24 <u>a lien on:</u>
- 25 (1) each animal left with the facility;
- 26 (2) the products from each animal; and
- 27 (3) all proceeds from the disposition of each animal,

- 1 <u>its carcass, or its products.</u>
- 2 (c) A lien under this section secures the amount of charges
- 3 due under an agreement or, if an amount is not specified by
- 4 agreement, the reasonable and usual compensation for services that
- 5 are similar to the services provided by the terminal livestock
- 6 feeding facility.
- 7 (d) Notwithstanding Chapter 9, Business & Commerce Code, or
- 8 any other law, a lien under this section attaches on the date on
- 9 which a terminal livestock feeding facility first provides feed and
- 10 care to an animal left with the facility and is perfected on
- 11 attachment and remains perfected without further action by the
- 12 facility, including the filing of a financial statement. Until the
- 13 lien is satisfied, the lien continues as to the animal, its carcass,
- 14 its products, and any proceeds from the disposition of the animal,
- 15 its carcass, or its products regardless of whether the facility
- 16 <u>retains possession of the animal.</u>
- 17 (e) A lien under this section has priority over any other
- 18 lien or perfected security interest in an animal, its carcass, its
- 19 products, or any proceeds from the disposition of the animal, its
- 20 carcass, or its products, regardless of whether the lien under this
- 21 section was created or perfected after the date on which another
- 22 <u>lien was created or perfected.</u>
- 23 <u>(f) A person who acquires an interest in an animal, its</u>
- 24 carcass, its products, or any proceeds from the disposition of the
- 25 <u>animal</u>, its carcass, or its products subject to a lien under this
- 26 section shall pay to the terminal livestock feeding facility the
- 27 amount of the charges secured by the lien.

- 1 (g) A terminal livestock feeding facility holding a lien
- 2 under this section may enforce that lien in any manner authorized by
- 3 Chapter 9, Business & Commerce Code, and may recover:
- 4 (1) the reasonable costs of collection and
- 5 enforcement; and
- 6 (2) the reasonable attorney's fees and legal expenses
- 7 <u>incurred by the facility.</u>
- 8 (h) A provision of this section that relates to the
- 9 creation, attachment, perfection, or enforcement of a lien controls
- 10 to the extent of a conflict with Chapter 9, Business & Commerce
- 11 Code, or other applicable law.
- 12 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
