H.B. No. 3162

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to the duty of an excavator to notify a notification center
- 3 or to make a 9-1-1 emergency call in response to underground
- 4 facility damage or an emergency.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 251.152, Utilities Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 251.152. INFORMATION INCLUDED IN NOTICE. The
- 9 excavator shall include in the notice required under Sections
- 10 [Section] 251.151 and 251.155:
- 11 (1) the name of the person serving the notice;
- 12 (2) the location of the proposed area of excavation,
- 13 including:
- 14 (A) the street address, if available, and the
- 15 location of the excavation at the street address; or
- 16 (B) if there is no street address, an accurate
- 17 description of the excavation area using any available designations
- 18 such as the closest street, road, or intersection;
- 19 (3) the name, address, and telephone number of the
- 20 excavator or the excavator's company;
- 21 (4) the excavator's field telephone number, if one is
- 22 available;
- 23 (5) for an excavation that is not an emergency, a
- 24 telephone facsimile number, e-mail address, or another electronic

- 1 number or address approved by the board to which an operator may
- 2 send the notification required by Section 251.157(d);
- 3 (6) the starting date and time and the anticipated
- 4 completion date of excavation; [and]
- 5 (7) a statement as to whether explosives will be used;
- 6 <u>and</u>
- 7 (8) for an emergency excavation, information about the
- 8 conditions that create the emergency.
- 9 SECTION 2. Sections 251.155(b) and (c), Utilities Code, are
- 10 amended to read as follows:
- 11 (b) If the emergency involves a flammable material, the
- 12 [The] excavator:
- 13 (1) may begin emergency excavation under Subsection
- 14 (a) immediately, before notifying a notification center;
- 15 (2) shall notify a notification center as promptly as
- 16 practicably possible; and
- 17 (3) shall take reasonable care to protect underground
- 18 facilities.
- 19 (c) If the emergency does not involve a flammable material,
- 20 the excavator:
- 21 (1) [When an emergency exists, the excavator] shall
- 22 notify a notification center as promptly as practicably possible;
- (2) may begin emergency excavation only after
- 24 notifying the notification center; and
- 25 (3) shall take reasonable care to protect underground
- 26 facilities.
- 27 SECTION 3. Section 251.159, Utilities Code, is amended by

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- 1 amending Subsections (a) and (b) and adding Subsection (a-1) to
- 2 read as follows:
- 3 (a) If an excavation operation results in damage to an
- 4 underground facility, including the defacing, scraping,
- 5 displacement, penetration, destruction, or partial or complete
- 6 severance or weakening of a protective coating, housing, or other
- 7 protective device or structural or lateral support of a pipeline,
- 8 the excavator shall immediately contact a notification center [the
- 9 underground facility operator] to report the damage and, except as
- 10 provided by Subsection (b), contact the underground facility
- 11 operator.
- 12 <u>(a-1) If an excavation operation results in a release of</u>
- 13 materials transported by an underground facility, the excavator
- 14 shall immediately make a 9-1-1 emergency call to report the
- 15 release. Immediately after concluding the 9-1-1 emergency call,
- 16 the excavator shall contact a notification center to report the
- 17 release and, except as provided by Subsection (b), contact the
- 18 underground facility operator.
- 19 (b) If the excavator is not certain of the operator's
- 20 identity, the excavator shall contact a notification center to
- 21 report the damage, after complying with Subsection (a-1), if
- 22 applicable, and the notification center shall immediately notify
- 23 all other affected notification centers. Immediately on receiving
- 24 notification, each notification center shall contact each member
- 25 operator that has underground facilities in or near the area in
- 26 which the damage occurred.
- 27 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
