A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the consideration of modeled sustainable groundwater pumping in the adoption of desired future conditions in groundwater 3 conservation districts. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Section 36.001, Water Code, is amended by adding Subdivision (32) to read as follows: 7 (32) "Modeled sustainable groundwater pumping" means 8 9 the maximum amount of groundwater that the executive administrator determines may be produced in perpetuity from an aquifer on an 10 annual basis using the best available science. 11 SECTION 2. Section 36.108(d), Water Code, is amended to 12 read as follows: 13 14 (d) Not later than September 1, 2010, and every five years thereafter, the districts shall consider groundwater availability 15 16 models and other data or information for the management area and shall propose for adoption desired future conditions for the 17 relevant aquifers within the management area. Before voting on the 18 proposed desired future conditions of the aquifers under Subsection 19 20 (d-2), the districts shall consider: 21 (1)aquifer uses or conditions within the management

22 area, including conditions that differ substantially from one 23 geographic area to another;

24 (2) the water supply needs and water management

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1 strategies included in the state water plan;

(3) hydrological conditions, including for each
aquifer in the management area the total estimated recoverable
storage <u>and modeled sustainable groundwater pumping</u> as provided by
the executive administrator, and the average annual recharge,
inflows, and discharge;

7 (4) other environmental impacts, including impacts on
8 spring flow and other interactions between groundwater and surface
9 water;

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(5) the impact on subsidence;

11 (6) socioeconomic impacts reasonably expected to
12 occur;

13 (7) the impact on the interests and rights in private 14 property, including ownership and the rights of management area 15 landowners and their lessees and assigns in groundwater as 16 recognized under Section 36.002;

17 (8) the feasibility of achieving the desired future18 condition; and

19 (9) any other information relevant to the specific20 desired future conditions.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
