A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the use of a broker for the exchange of land by a
- 3 political subdivision.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 272.001(a), Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Except for the types of land and interests covered by
- 8 Subsection (b), (g), (h), (i), (j), or (l), and except as provided
- 9 by Section 253.008 or 272.007, before land owned by a political
- 10 subdivision of the state may be sold or exchanged for other land,
- 11 notice to the general public of the offer of the land for sale or
- 12 exchange must be published in a newspaper of general circulation in
- 13 either the county in which the land is located or, if there is no
- 14 such newspaper, in an adjoining county. The notice must include a
- 15 description of the land, including its location, and the procedure
- 16 by which sealed bids to purchase the land or offers to exchange the
- 17 land may be submitted. The notice must be published on two
- 18 separate dates and the sale or exchange may not be made until after
- 19 the 14th day after the date of the second publication.
- 20 SECTION 2. Chapter 272, Local Government Code, is amended
- 21 by adding Section 272.007 to read as follows:
- 22 Sec. 272.007. BROKER AGREEMENTS AND FEES FOR SALE OF REAL
- 23 PROPERTY. (a) In this section, "broker" means a person licensed as
- 24 a broker under Chapter 1101, Occupations Code.

- 1 (b) A political subdivision may contract with a broker to
- 2 lease or sell a tract of real property that is owned by the
- 3 political subdivision.
- 4 (c) The governing body of a home-rule municipality may
- 5 contract with a broker to sell a tract of real property that the
- 6 municipality holds in trust and has the authority to sell.
- 7 (d) The political subdivision may pay a fee if a broker
- 8 produces a ready, willing, and able buyer to purchase a tract of
- 9 real property.
- 10 (e) If a contract made under Subsection (b) or (c) requires
- 11 <u>a broker to list the tract of real property for sale for at least 30</u>
- 12 days with a multiple-listing service used by other brokers in the
- 13 county, the political subdivision on or after the 30th day after the
- 14 date the property is listed may sell the tract of real property to a
- 15 ready, willing, and able buyer who is produced by any broker using
- 16 the multiple-listing service and who submits the most advantageous
- 17 offer.
- 18 (f) The political subdivision must post a notice of intent
- 19 to sell the real property in a newspaper of general circulation, not
- 20 less than once, at least fourteen days before the date the political
- 21 subdivision accepts an offer produced by a broker.
- 22 (g) The political subdivision may sell a tract of real
- 23 property under this section without complying with the requirements
- 24 of Section 253.008, 263.001, or 272.001.
- 25 SECTION 3. Sections 253.014 and 263.008, Local Government
- 26 Code, are repealed.
- 27 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
