## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to an exemption from payment of tolls for certain
- 3 vehicles.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 228.054(a), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (e) or Section
- 8 228.0545, the operator of a vehicle, other than an authorized
- 9 emergency vehicle or a vehicle exempt from payment of registration
- 10 fees under Subchapter J, Chapter 502 [, as defined by Section
- 11 541.201], that is driven or towed through a toll collection
- 12 facility shall pay the proper toll. The exemption from payment of a
- 13 toll for an authorized emergency vehicle applies regardless of
- 14 whether the vehicle is:
- 15 (1) responding to an emergency;
- 16 (2) displaying a flashing light; or
- 17 (3) marked as an emergency vehicle.
- SECTION 2. Section 284.070, Transportation Code, is amended
- 19 by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 20 <u>(f) A vehicle exempt from payment of registration fees under</u>
- 21 Subchapter J, Chapter 502, is exempt from payment of a toll imposed
- 22 under this chapter.
- SECTION 3. Section 366.178, Transportation Code, is amended
- 24 by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as

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1 follows:
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- 2 (a) A motor vehicle, other than an authorized emergency
- 3 vehicle or a vehicle exempt from payment of registration fees under
- 4 Subchapter J, Chapter 502 [, as defined by Section 541.201], that
- 5 passes through a toll assessment facility, whether driven or towed,
- 6 shall pay the proper toll. The exemption from payment of a toll for
- 7 an authorized emergency vehicle applies regardless of whether the
- 8 vehicle is:
- 9 (1) responding to an emergency;
- 10 (2) displaying a flashing light; or
- 11 (3) marked as a police or emergency vehicle.
- 12 <u>(a-1)</u> In this section, "authorized emergency vehicle" has
- 13 the meaning assigned by Section 541.201.
- 14 SECTION 4. Sections 370.177(a) and (k), Transportation
- 15 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 16 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (a-1), the operator of
- 17 a vehicle, other than an authorized emergency vehicle or a vehicle
- 18 that is exempt from payment of registration fees under Subchapter
- 19 J, Chapter 502 [as defined by Section 541.201], that is driven or
- 20 towed through a toll collection facility of a turnpike project
- 21 shall pay the proper toll. The operator of a vehicle who drives or
- 22 tows a vehicle through a toll collection facility and does not pay
- 23 the proper toll commits an offense. An offense under this
- 24 subsection is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed \$250.
- 25 The exemption from payment of a toll for an authorized emergency
- 26 vehicle applies regardless of whether the vehicle is:
- 27 (1) responding to an emergency;

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- 1 (2) displaying a flashing light; or
- 2 (3) marked as an emergency vehicle.
- 3 (k) In this section:
- 4 (1) "Authorized emergency vehicle" has the meaning
- 5 <u>assigned by Section 541.201.</u>
- 6 (2) "Registered [ registered ] owner" means the owner
- 7 of a vehicle as shown on the vehicle registration records of the
- 8 department or the analogous department or agency of another state
- 9 or country.
- 10 SECTION 5. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 11 to the collection of a toll incurred on or after the effective date
- 12 of this Act. The collection of a toll incurred before the effective
- 13 date of this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before
- 14 the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect
- 15 for that purpose.
- SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
