- 6 SECTION 2. Section 30A.002(b), Education Code, is repealed.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018
- 8 school year.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
