## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the costs associated with the provision of certain
- 3 investigational drugs, biological products, and devices that are in
- 4 clinical trials.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 489.053(c), Health and Safety Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (c) A [<del>If a</del>] manufacturer may:
- 9 (1) provide [makes available] an investigational
- 10 drug, biological product, or device to an eligible patient under
- 11 this subchapter [ the manufacturer must provide the
- 12 investigational drug, biological product, or device to the eligible
- 13 patient] without receiving compensation; or
- 14 (2) require an eligible patient under this subchapter
- 15 to pay the costs of, or the costs associated with, the manufacture
- 16 of the investigational drug, biological product, or device.
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 18 to an investigational drug, biological product, or device provided
- 19 to an eligible patient on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 20 An investigational drug, biological product, or device provided to
- 21 an eligible patient before the effective date of this Act is
- 22 governed by the law in effect on the date the investigational drug,
- 23 biological product, or device was provided, and the former law is
- 24 continued in effect for that purpose.

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1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
