6	SECTION 1. Chapter 97, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 97.003 to read as follows:

- 8 Sec. 97.003. LIMIT ON LIABILITY OF GAS UTILITIES PROVIDING
- 9 ASSISTANCE TO GOVERNMENTAL UNITS AND INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER
- 10 EDUCATION. (a) In this section:
- 11 (1) "Emergency" means a situation that endangers life,
- 12 health, or property or a situation in which the public need for
- 13 uninterrupted service provided by the gas pipeline or immediate
- 14 reestablishment of service if service is interrupted compels
- 15 immediate action.
- 16 (2) "Gas utility" has the meaning assigned by Sections
- 17 <u>101.003</u> and <u>121.001</u>, <u>Utilities Code</u>.
- 18 (3) "Governmental unit" has the meaning assigned by
- 19 <u>Section 101.001.</u>
- 20 (4) "Institution of higher education" has the meaning
- 21 assigned by Section 61.003, Education Code.
- 22 (b) A gas utility that inspects, constructs, or repairs a
- 23 gas pipeline owned or operated by a governmental unit or an
- 24 institution of higher education is not liable to a claimant for

- 1 personal injury, property damage, or death arising from the
- 2 performance of the inspection, construction, or repair if, at the
- 3 time of the personal injury, property damage, or death, the gas
- 4 utility was providing services or materials at the request of the
- 5 governmental unit or institution of higher education in response to
- 6 an emergency, and the personal injury, property damage, or death
- 7 was not caused by the gas utility's wilful misconduct.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 97.003, Civil Practice and Remedies
- 9 Code, as added by this Act, applies only to a cause of action that
- 10 accrues on or after the effective date of this Act. A cause of
- 11 action that accrued before the effective date of this Act is
- 12 governed by the law applicable to the action immediately before the
- 13 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for
- 14 that purpose.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
