- 11 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 12 an application for receipt of a matching grant from the governor's
- 13 university research initiative that is submitted on or after the
- 14 effective date of this Act. An application for receipt of a
- 15 matching grant from the governor's university research initiative
- 16 that is submitted before the effective date of this Act is governed
- 17 by the law in effect on the date the application is submitted, and
- 18 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 19 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
