A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to public work contracts of governmental entities.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 2269, Government Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 2269.0525 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 2269.0525. PREQUALIFICATION PROCESS. (a) A
7	governmental entity may implement a prequalification process to
8	eliminate unqualified offerors from consideration for a public work
9	project under a method authorized by this chapter. A governmental
10	entity that implements a prequalification process shall advertise
11	or publish notice of the prequalification process along with a
12	request for qualifications in a manner prescribed by law. In
13	addition, the governmental entity may directly solicit
14	qualifications from potential offerors if the competitive
15	requirements of this chapter and other applicable law are followed.
16	(b) If a governmental entity considers a construction
17	contract using competitive bidding under this chapter, in
18	implementing a prequalification process under Subsection (a), the
19	<pre>governmental entity:</pre>
20	(1) may not rank potential offerors; and
21	(2) shall determine if any potential offerors meet
22	minimum qualification requirements for completing the construction
23	contract.
24	(c) A governmental entity may consider the following

- 1 factors during the prequalification process:
- 2 (1) the potential offeror's experience with other
- 3 construction projects for the governmental entity;
- 4 (2) the potential offeror's commercial and financial
- 5 history and stability;
- 6 (3) the potential offeror's ability to self-perform
- 7 the construction project services;
- 8 (4) the potential offeror's familiarity and experience
- 9 with subcontractors and suppliers in the area served by the
- 10 governmental entity;
- 11 (5) whether the potential offeror has been involved in
- 12 litigation related to a construction project during the preceding
- 13 five years;
- 14 (6) the potential offeror's ability and capacity to
- 15 provide performance and payment bonds;
- 16 (7) whether the potential offeror has ever failed to
- 17 complete a project for a governmental entity;
- 18 (8) the potential offeror's experience with
- 19 construction projects of similar size and scope; and
- 20 (9) the qualifications and experience of the potential
- 21 offeror's proposed project team.
- 22 SECTION 2. Section 2269.055, Government Code, is amended to
- 23 read as follows:
- Sec. 2269.055. CRITERIA TO CONSIDER. (a) In determining
- 25 the award of a contract under this chapter, the governmental entity
- 26 may consider:
- 27 (1) the price;

- 1 (2) the offeror's experience $\underline{\text{with similar construction}}$
- 2 projects and reputation;
- 3 (3) the quality of the offeror's goods or services;
- 4 (4) the impact on the ability of the governmental
- 5 entity to comply with rules relating to historically underutilized
- 6 businesses;
- 7 (5) the offeror's safety record;
- 8 (6) the offeror's proposed personnel;
- 9 (7) whether the offeror's financial capability is
- 10 appropriate to the size and scope of the project; and
- 11 (8) any other relevant factor specifically listed in
- 12 the request for bids, proposals, or qualifications.
- 13 (b) In determining the award of a contract under this
- 14 chapter, the governmental entity shall:
- 15 (1) consider and apply any existing laws, including
- 16 any criteria, related to historically underutilized businesses;
- 17 [and]
- 18 (2) consider and apply any existing laws, rules, or
- 19 applicable municipal charters, including laws applicable to local
- 20 governments, related to the use of women, minority, small, or
- 21 disadvantaged businesses; and
- 22 (3) consider good faith efforts to comply with laws,
- 23 rules, or applicable municipal charters described by Subdivision
- 24 (2).
- 25 (c) In this section, "good faith effort" means documented
- 26 evidence of outreach to enlist services, or bids and proposals,
- 27 from available, certified, and qualified businesses.

- 1 SECTION 3. Section 2269.056(b), Government Code, is amended
- 2 to read as follows:
- 3 (b) The governmental entity shall base its selection among
- 4 offerors on applicable criteria listed for the particular method
- 5 used. The governmental entity shall publish in the request for
- 6 proposals or qualifications the:
- 7 $\underline{(1)}$ criteria that will be used to evaluate the
- 8 offerors;
- 9 (2) [, and the] applicable weighted value for each
- 10 criterion; and
- 11 (3) detailed methodology for scoring each criterion.
- 12 SECTION 4. Subchapter B, Chapter 2269, Government Code, is
- 13 amended by adding Section 2269.0565 to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 2269.0565. EXPLANATION OF EVALUATION AND RANKING. (a)
- 15 An offeror who submits a bid, proposal, or qualification for a
- 16 construction contract under this chapter and who is not awarded the
- 17 contract may make a request in writing to the governmental entity to
- 18 provide an explanation of its evaluation and, if applicable,
- 19 ranking of the offeror's submission if the submission was:
- 20 (1) evaluated or ranked differently than a comparable
- 21 submission from the offeror to the governmental entity during the
- 22 preceding year;
- 23 (2) developed using the same data that was used to
- 24 develop the offeror's previous submission; and
- 25 (3) evaluated or ranked using the same criteria that
- 26 was used to evaluate or rank the offeror's previous submission.
- (b) Not later than the 30th day after the date a request is

- 1 made under Subsection (a), the governmental entity shall deliver to
- 2 the offeror a written explanation of its evaluation and, if
- 3 applicable, ranking of the offeror's submission, including an
- 4 explanation of why the submission was evaluated or ranked
- 5 differently than the offeror's previous submission to the
- 6 governmental entity.
- 7 SECTION 5. Section 2269.103, Government Code, is amended to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 2269.103. PREPARATION OF REQUEST. (a) The
- 10 governmental entity shall prepare a request for competitive bids
- 11 that includes construction documents, estimated budget, project
- 12 scope, estimated project completion date, and other information
- 13 that a contractor may require to submit a bid.
- 14 (b) Before preparing a request for competitive bids under
- 15 Subsection (a), a governmental entity may use the prequalification
- 16 process described by Section 2269.0525.
- 17 SECTION 6. Section 2269.153, Government Code, is amended to
- 18 read as follows:
- 19 Sec. 2269.153. PREPARATION OF REQUEST. (a) The
- 20 governmental entity shall prepare a request for competitive sealed
- 21 proposals that includes construction documents, selection criteria
- 22 and the weighted value for each criterion, estimated budget,
- 23 project scope, estimated project completion date, and other
- 24 information that a contractor may require to respond to the
- 25 request.
- 26 (b) Before preparing a request for competitive sealed
- 27 proposals under Subsection (a), a governmental entity may use the

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1 prequalification process described by Section 2269.0525.

- 2 SECTION 7. The change in law made by this Act applies only to a public work contract for which a governmental entity first 3 advertises or otherwise solicits bids, proposals, offers, or 4 qualifications or makes a similar solicitation on or after the 5 6 effective date of this Act. A public work contract for which a governmental entity first advertises or otherwise solicits bids, 7 proposals, offers, or qualifications or makes a similar solicitation before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the advertisement or solicitation is 10 made, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose. 11
- 12 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
