1 Sec. 451.114. CONTRACT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES: CERTAIN 2 AUTHORITIES. In procuring architectural, engineering, or design services, an authority in which the principal municipality has a 3 4 population of 1.9 million or more shall incorporate the selection process for those services as provided by Section 2254.004, 5 Government Code. 6 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 10

11 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
