- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 755.001(17), Health and Safety Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (17) "Portable [power] boiler" means a boiler
- 7 primarily intended for use at a temporary location.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 755.022(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 9 amended to read as follows:
- 10 (a) This chapter does not apply to:
- 11 (1) boilers owned or operated by the federal
- 12 government;
- 13 (2) pressure vessels or process steam generators,
- 14 other than steam collection or liberation drums of process steam
- 15 generators;
- 16 (3) manually fired miniature boilers that:
- 17 (A) are constructed or maintained for
- 18 locomotives, boats, tractors, or stationary engines only as a hobby
- 19 for exhibition, recreation, education, or historical purposes and
- 20 not for commercial use;
- 21 (B) have an inside diameter of 12 inches or less
- 22 or a grate area of two square feet or less; and
- (C) are equipped with a safety valve of adequate
- 24 size, a water level indicator, and a pressure gauge;

- 1 (4) boilers that are designed for operation only at
- 2 atmospheric pressure and that are equipped with two independent

- 6 SECTION 3. Section 755.025(e), Health and Safety Code, is 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (e) The commission by rule shall establish the subsequent
- 9 intervals and manner of inspection for a [A] portable [power]
- 10 boiler [must be inspected externally each time the boiler is moved
- 11 to a new location and must receive an internal inspection at least
- 12 annually].
- 13 SECTION 4. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 14 of this Act, the Texas Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall
- 15 adopt the rules necessary to implement the changes in law made by
- 16 this Act.
- 17 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
