- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1301.704, Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows:
- 7 (c) Failure to request a hearing or accept the determination
- 8 and recommended penalty within the time provided by this section
- 9 waives the right to a hearing under this chapter.
- 10 (d) If the board determines without a hearing that the
- 11 person committed a violation and a penalty is to be imposed, the
- 12 board shall:
- 13 (1) provide written notice to the person of the board's
- 14 findings; and
- 15 (2) enter an order requiring the person to pay the
- 16 recommended penalty.
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 1301.705(a), Occupations Code, is
- 18 amended to read as follows:
- 19 (a) If the person requests a hearing [or fails to respond in
- 20 a timely manner to the notice], the enforcement committee shall set
- 21 a hearing and give written notice of the hearing to the person. An
- 22 administrative law judge of the State Office of Administrative
- 23 Hearings shall hold the hearing.
- SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act to Section

- 1 1301.704, Occupations Code, applies only to imposition of an
- 2 administrative penalty against a person who receives notice under
- 3 Section 1301.703(b), Occupations Code, on or after the effective
- 4 date of this Act. An administrative penalty for which notice under
- 5 that section is received before the effective date of this Act is
- 6 governed by the law in effect on the date the notice was received,
- 7 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
