10	(d) If the board determines without a hearing that the
11	person committed a violation and a penalty is to be imposed, the
12	board shall:
13	(1) provide written notice to the person of the board's
14	findings; and
15	(2) enter an order requiring the person to pay the
16	recommended penalty.
17	SECTION 2. Section 1301.705(a), Occupations Code, is
18	amended to read as follows:
19	(a) If the person requests a hearing [ <del>or fails to respond in</del>
20	a timely manner to the notice], the enforcement committee shall set
21	a hearing and give written notice of the hearing to the person. An
22	administrative law judge of the State Office of Administrative
23	Hearings shall hold the hearing.
24	SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act to Section

1 1301.704, Occupations Code, applies only to imposition of an administrative penalty against a person who receives notice under Section 1301.703(b), Occupations Code, on or after the effective date of this Act. An administrative penalty for which notice under that section is received before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the notice was received, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
