A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to eligibility requirements for the specialized
- 3 telecommunications assistance program.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 56.151(a), Utilities Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) The executive commissioner, after consulting with the
- 8 department, by rule shall establish a specialized
- 9 telecommunications assistance program to provide financial
- 10 assistance to individuals <u>diagnosed</u> by a medical professional as a
- 11 deaf individual, an individual who has an impairment of hearing, or
- 12 <u>an individual who has an impairment of speech</u> [with disabilities
- 13 that impair the individuals' ability to effectively access the
- 14 telephone network] to assist the individuals with the purchase of
- 15 basic specialized equipment or services to provide the individuals
- 16 with telephone network access that is functionally equivalent to
- 17 that enjoyed by individuals without disabilities of hearing or
- 18 speech. The executive commissioner may adopt rules that identify
- 19 devices and services eligible for vouchers under the program.
- SECTION 2. Section 56.152, Utilities Code, is amended to
- 21 read as follows:
- Sec. 56.152. ELIGIBILITY. The executive commissioner,
- 23 after consulting with the department, by rule shall prescribe
- 24 eligibility standards for individuals, including deaf individuals

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- 1 and individuals who have an impairment of hearing or speech, to
- 2 receive an assistance voucher under the program. To be eligible, an
- 3 individual must:
- 4 (1) be a resident of this state;
- 5 (2) be diagnosed by a medical professional as a deaf
- 6 individual, an individual who has an impairment of hearing, or an
- 7 <u>individual who has an impairment of speech; and</u>
- 8 (3) have an income at or below 150 percent of the
- 9 federal poverty guidelines [with a disability that impairs the
- 10 individual's ability to effectively access the telephone network].
- SECTION 3. Sections 56.153(d) and (e), Utilities Code, are
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 (d) An individual who has exchanged a voucher for a
- 14 specialized telecommunications device is not eligible to receive
- 15 another voucher before the fifth anniversary of the date the
- 16 individual exchanged the previously issued voucher unless, before
- 17 that date, the recipient develops a need for a different type of
- 18 telecommunications device or service under the program because the
- 19 recipient's diagnosis has changed to the extent that the device is
- 20 no longer adequate to meet the individual's network access needs
- 21 [disability changes or the recipient acquires another disability].
- (e) Except as provided by rules adopted under this
- 23 subsection, an individual is not eligible for a voucher if the
- 24 department has issued a voucher for a device or service to another
- 25 individual with the same diagnosis [type of disability] in the
- 26 individual's household. The executive commissioner, after
- 27 consulting with the department, by rule may provide for financially

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- 1 independent individuals who reside in a congregate setting to be
- 2 eligible for a voucher regardless of whether another individual
- 3 living in that setting has received a voucher.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
