1-17 relating to the eligibility of certain municipalities to establish  
1-18 homestead preservation districts and reinvestment zones.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 373A.003, Local Government Code, is  
1-21 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to  
1-22 read as follows:

1-23 (a) This chapter applies to a municipality with a population  
1-24 of more than 750,000 that is located in a uniform state service  
1-25 region with fewer than 800,000 [~~550,000~~] occupied housing units as  
1-26 determined by the most recent United States decennial census.

1-27 (a-1) If this chapter applies to a municipality as provided  
1-28 by Subsection (a), the application of this chapter to the  
1-29 municipality is not affected if the municipality's population or  
1-30 number of occupied housing units changes and the municipality no  
1-31 longer meets the population requirement of Subsection (a).

1-32 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
