C.S.H.B. No. 3295

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT
2 relating to the delivery of certain Medicaid services to persons
3 with an intellectual or developmental disability.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 534.111, Government Code, is amended to
6 read as follows:

7 Sec. 534.111. CONCLUSION OF PILOT PROGRAMS;
8 EXPIRATION. On September 1, 2019 [~~2018~~]:

9 (1) each pilot program established under this
10 subchapter that is still in operation must conclude; and

11 (2) this subchapter expires.

12 SECTION 2. Section 534.201(b), Government Code, is amended
13 to read as follows:

14 (b) On September 1, 2020 [~~2018~~], the commission shall
15 transition the provision of Medicaid benefits to individuals to
16 whom this section applies to the STAR + PLUS Medicaid managed care
17 program delivery model or the most appropriate integrated capitated
18 managed care program delivery model, as determined by the
19 commission based on cost-effectiveness and the experience of the
20 STAR + PLUS Medicaid managed care program in providing basic
21 attendant and habilitation services and of the pilot programs
22 established under Subchapter C, subject to Subsection (c)(1).

23 SECTION 3. If before implementing any provision of this Act
24 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a

1 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
2 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
3 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
4 waiver or authorization is granted.

5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
