- 5 ARTICLE 1. ENTITIES GIVEN 2019 SUNSET DATE
- 6 SECTION 1.01. BANDERA COUNTY RIVER AUTHORITY AND
- 7 GROUNDWATER DISTRICT. Section 1A(a), Chapter 629, Acts of the 62nd
- 8 Legislature, Regular Session, 1971, is amended to read as follows:
- 9 (a) The district is subject to review under Chapter 325,
- 10 Government Code (Texas Sunset Act), but may not be abolished under
- 11 that chapter. The review shall be conducted under Section 325.025,
- 12 Government Code, as if the district were a state agency scheduled to
- 13 be abolished September 1, 2019 [2023], and every 12th year after
- 14 that year.
- 15 SECTION 1.02. LAVACA-NAVIDAD RIVER AUTHORITY. Section

- 12 the Teacher Retirement System of Texas is subject to review under
- 13 Chapter 325 (Texas Sunset Act), but is not abolished under that

- 15 state agencies abolished in 2025 [2019], and every 12th year after
- 16 that year, are reviewed.

- 6 BOARD. Section 1103.006, Occupations Code, is amended to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 Sec. 1103.006. APPLICATION OF SUNSET ACT. The Texas
- 9 Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board is subject to Chapter
- 10 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in
- 11 existence as provided by that chapter, the board is abolished and
- 12 this chapter and Chapter 1104 expire September 1, 2025 [2019].

- 16 SECTION 5.02. MATERNAL MORTALITY AND MORBIDITY TASK FORCE.
- 17 Section 34.018, Health and Safety Code, is repealed.
- 18 SECTION 5.03. PALLIATIVE CARE INTERDISCIPLINARY ADVISORY
- 19 COUNCIL. Section 118.003, Health and Safety Code, is repealed.
- 20 SECTION 5.04. PERINATAL ADVISORY COUNCIL. Section
- 21 241.187(1), Health and Safety Code, is repealed.
- 22 SECTION 5.05. TEXAS WINDSTORM INSURANCE ASSOCIATION.
- 23 Section 2210.002, Insurance Code, is amended to read as follows:

- 25 This chapter may be cited as the Texas Windstorm Insurance

- 11 ARTICLE 6. SUNSET REVIEW PROCESS
- 12 SECTION 6.01. DEFINITIONS. Section 325.002(1), Government
- 13 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 14 (1) "State agency" means an entity [agency] expressly
- 15 made subject to this chapter.
- 16 SECTION 6.02. SUNSET ADVISORY COMMISSION. Section
- 17 325.003(a), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 18 (a) The Sunset Advisory Commission is a legislative agency
- 19 that consists of five members of the senate and one public member
- 20 appointed by the lieutenant governor and five members of the house
- 21 of representatives and one public member appointed by the speaker
- 22 of the house. The lieutenant governor and the speaker of the house
- 23 may serve as one of the legislative appointees.
- SECTION 6.03. COMMISSION DUTIES. Section 325.008(a),
- 25 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 26 (a) Before January 1 of the year in which a state agency
- 27 subject to this chapter and its advisory committees are abolished,

- 1 the commission shall:
- 2 (1) review and take action necessary to verify the
- 3 reports submitted by the agency under Section 325.007;
- 4 (2) consult the Legislative Budget Board, the
- 5 Governor's Budget, Policy, and Planning Division, the State
- 6 Auditor, and the comptroller of public accounts, or their
- 7 successors, on the application to the agency of the criteria
- 8 provided in Section 325.011;
- 9 (3) conduct a review of the agency based on the
- 10 criteria provided in Section 325.011 and prepare a written report;
- 11 and
- 12 (4) review the implementation of commission
- 13 recommendations contained in the reports presented to the
- 14 legislature during the preceding legislative session and the
- 15 resulting legislation and prepare a written report.
- SECTION 6.04. RECOMMENDATIONS. Section 325.012(c),
- 17 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 18 (c) The commission shall have drafts of legislation
- 19 prepared to carry out the commission's recommendations under this
- 20 section. The commission staff shall provide legislative services
- 21 to support the passage of legislation prepared under this section.
- 22 SECTION 6.05. RECORDS PROTECTED FROM DISCLOSURE. Section
- 23 325.0195, Government Code, is amended by amending Subsection (a)
- 24 and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 25 (a) A working paper, including all documentary or other
- 26 information, prepared or maintained by the commission staff in
- 27 performing its duties under this chapter or other law to conduct an

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- 1 evaluation, [and] prepare a report, draft legislation, or provide
- 2 legislative services is privileged and confidential and not subject
- 3 to discovery or subpoena, and is excepted from the public
- 4 disclosure requirements of Section 552.021.
- 5 (a-1) Any record or communication that is held by a state
- 6 agency being reviewed under this chapter that is either prepared
- 7 for the commission by the state agency or provided to the state
- 8 agency by the commission is confidential and excepted from the
- 9 public disclosure requirements of Section 552.021. If information
- 10 or data within a record or communication made confidential under
- 11 this subsection is also maintained in another record, that other
- 12 record is not made confidential or excepted from public disclosure
- 13 by this subsection.
- 14 SECTION 6.06. REPEALER. Sections 325.020 and 325.0123(a),
- 15 Government Code, are repealed.
- 16 ARTICLE 7. EFFECTIVE DATE
- 17 SECTION 7.01. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 18 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 19 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 20 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 21 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
