## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the provision of counseling services by certain

- 3 providers under Medicaid and reimbursement for those services.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 32.027, Human Resources Code, is amended
- 6 by amending Subsection (1) and adding Subsection (m) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (1) Subject to appropriations, the commission shall assure
- 9 that a recipient of medical assistance under this chapter may
- 10 select a licensed psychologist, a licensed marriage and family
- 11 therapist, as defined by Section 502.002, Occupations Code, or a
- 12 licensed professional counselor, as defined by Section 503.002,
- 13 Occupations Code, [or a licensed master social worker, as defined
- 14 by Section 505.002, Occupations Code, operform any health care
- 15 service or procedure covered under the medical assistance program
- 16 if the selected person is authorized by law to perform the service
- 17 or procedure. This subsection shall be liberally construed.
- 18 (m) The commission shall assure that a recipient of medical
- 19 <u>assistance under this chapter may select the following to perform</u>
- 20 any health care service or procedure covered under the medical
- 21 assistance program if the selected person is authorized by law to
- 22 perform the service or procedure:
- 23 (1) a licensed master social worker, as defined by
- 24 Section 505.002, Occupations Code, who is actively pursuing the

- 1 education and training required to be licensed as a licensed
- 2 clinical social worker, as defined by that section; or
- 3 (2) a licensed professional counselor intern who is
- 4 working toward fulfilling the supervised practice requirements to
- 5 be licensed as a licensed professional counselor, as defined by
- 6 Section 503.002, Occupations Code.
- 7 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 32, Human Resources Code,
- 8 is amended by adding Section 32.079 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 32.079. REIMBURSEMENT FOR CERTAIN COUNSELING
- 10 SERVICES. The commission shall provide reimbursement under the
- 11 medical assistance program to a provider described by Section
- 12 32.027(m) who is selected by a recipient of medical assistance and
- 13 who provides counseling services covered under the medical
- 14 assistance program that the provider is authorized by law to
- 15 perform. The commission shall ensure that the provider is
- 16 reimbursed at a rate equal to 70 percent of the reimbursement rate
- 17 established for a licensed psychiatrist or licensed psychologist
- 18 for providing similar services.
- 19 SECTION 3. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 20 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 21 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 22 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 23 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 24 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 25 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
