 1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
 1-21 SECTION 1. Section 26.112, Government Code, is amended to  
 1-22 read as follows:  
 1-23 Sec. 26.112. BAYLOR COUNTY. The County Court of Baylor  
 1-24 County has the general jurisdiction of a probate court, ~~and~~ the  
 1-25 general criminal jurisdiction of a county court, and jurisdiction  
 1-26 over cases and proceedings involving protective orders but has no  
 1-27 other civil jurisdiction.  
 1-28 SECTION 2. Section 26.151, Government Code, is amended to  
 1-29 read as follows:  
 1-30 Sec. 26.151. COTTLE COUNTY. The County Court of Cottle  
 1-31 County has the general jurisdiction of a probate court, ~~and~~ the  
 1-32 general criminal jurisdiction of a county court, and jurisdiction  
 1-33 over cases and proceedings involving protective orders but has no  
 1-34 other civil jurisdiction.  
 1-35 SECTION 3. Section 26.235, Government Code, is amended to
