The department in cooperation with volunteer 8 9 advocates from a charitable organization described by Subchapter C, Chapter 107, and the Department of Public Safety shall develop 10 procedures to ensure that a foster child obtains a driver's license 11 12 or personal identification card before the child leaves the conservatorship of the department. 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 16
