C.S.H.B. No. 3347

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to before-school and after-school programs established by public school districts.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 33, Education Code, is amended by adding Section 33.9031 to read as follows:

Sec. 33.9031. BEFORE-SCHOOL AND AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAMS. (a)

The board of trustees of a school district may establish before-school or after-school programs for students enrolled in elementary or middle school grades. A program established under this section may operate before, after, or before and after school hours.

(b) A student is eligible to participate in a school district's before-school or after-school program if the student:

(1) is enrolled in a public or private school; or

(2) resides within the boundaries of the school district.

(c) A school district shall conduct a request for proposals procurement process to enable the district to determine if contracting with a child-care facility that provides a before-school or after-school program, as defined by Section 42.002, Human Resources Code, to provide the district's before-school or after-school program would serve the district's best interests. Following the request for proposals procurement

1 process, the district may enter into a contract with a child-care
2 facility or implement a before-school or after-school program
3 operated by the district. If the district enters into a contract
4 with a child-care facility, the contract must comply with the
5 requirements of Section 44.031 and may not exceed a term of three
6 years.

7 (d) The board of trustees of a school district may adopt
8 rules in accordance with Section 11.165 to provide access to school
9 campuses before or after school hours for the purpose of providing a
10 before-school or after-school program.

11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
15 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
