4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 21, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Sections 21.0442 and 21.0491 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 21.0442. EDUCATOR PREPARATION PROGRAM FOR TRADE AND
8	INDUSTRIAL WORKFORCE TRAINING CERTIFICATE. (a) The board shall
9	propose rules under this subchapter to create an abbreviated
10	educator preparation program for a person seeking certification in
11	trade and industrial workforce training.
12	(b) Subject to Subsection (c), a person is eligible for
13	admission to an educator preparation program created under this
14	section only if the person:
15	(1) has been issued a high school diploma;
16	(2) has 10 years of full-time wage-earning experience
17	within the preceding 12 years in an approved occupation for which
18	instruction is offered; and
10	(2) holds with respect to that assumation a surrent

- 20 license, certificate, or registration, as applicable, issued by a
- 21 nationally recognized accrediting agency based on a recognized test
- 22 <u>or measurement.</u>
- (c) The board may propose rules under which a person is
- 24 eligible for admission under Subsection (b) if the person has five

- 1 years of full-time wage-earning experience within the preceding
- 2 seven years in an approved occupation for which instruction is
- 3 offered if the person holds an advanced license, certificate, or
- 4 registration, as applicable, issued by a nationally recognized
- 5 accrediting agency.
- 6 (d) In proposing rules for an educator preparation program
- 7 under this section, the board shall ensure that the program
- 8 requires:
- 9 (1) instruction in:
- 10 (A) a specific pedagogy;
- 11 (B) classroom management; and
- 12 (C) relevant federal and state education laws;

- 14 (2) at least 25 hours of instruction and not more than
- 15 50 hours of instruction.
- 16 Sec. 21.0491. TRADE AND INDUSTRIAL WORKFORCE TRAINING
- 17 CERTIFICATE. (a) To provide a continuing additional source of
- 18 teachers to provide workforce training, the board shall establish a
- 19 trade and industrial workforce training certificate that may be
- 20 obtained through an abbreviated educator preparation program under
- 21 <u>Section 21.0442.</u>
- (b) To be eligible for a certificate under this section, a
- 23 person must:
- 24 (1) satisfactorily complete the course work for that
- 25 certificate in an educator preparation program under Section
- 26 21.0442;
- 27 (2) perform satisfactorily on a trade and industrial

- 1 workforce training certificate examination prescribed by the
- 2 board; and
- 3 (3) satisfy any other requirements prescribed by the
- 4 board.
- 5 SECTION 2. The State Board for Educator Certification shall
- 6 propose rules:
- 7 (1) establishing requirements and prescribing an
- 8 examination for a trade and industrial workforce training
- 9 certificate examination as required by Section 21.0491, Education
- 10 Code, as added by this Act; and
- 11 (2) establishing standards to govern the approval and
- 12 renewal of approval of educator preparation programs for
- 13 certification in trade and industrial workforce training.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
