- 2 relating to the use of money from the Texas Enterprise Fund to
- 3 reimburse grant recipients for certain expenses.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 481.078(c), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (c) Except as provided by Subsections (d) and (d-1), the
- 8 fund may be used only for:
- 9 (1) economic development, infrastructure development,
- 10 community development, job training programs, and business
- 11 incentives; and
- 12 (2) expense reimbursement for grant recipients under
- 13 this section as provided by Section 481.081.
- 14 SECTION 2. Subchapter E, Chapter 481, Government Code, is
- 15 amended by adding Section 481.081 to read as follows:
- 16 Sec. 481.081. TEXAS ENTERPRISE FUND: REIMBURSEMENT FOR
- 17 CERTAIN EXPENSES INCURRED BY GRANT RECIPIENT. (a) In this section,
- 18 "fund" means the Texas Enterprise Fund under Section 481.078.
- 19 (b) The governor may use money in the fund to reimburse a
- 20 grant recipient under Section 481.078 for a portion of the
- 21 recipient's expenses that are incurred:
- 22 (1) in the performance of the recipient's duties under
- 23 that section; and
- 24 (2) for the purchase of goods or services from a

- 1 business whose headquarters are located in this state.
- 2 (c) A grant recipient may apply for and receive
- 3 reimbursement for expenses as provided by this section in an
- 4 amount, as determined by office of the governor rule, not to exceed
- 5 15 percent of the total receipts for qualified expenditures the
- 6 recipient submits to the office of the governor in accordance with
- 7 this section.
- 8 (d) The office of the governor shall adopt any rules the
- 9 governor considers necessary for the administration and
- 10 implementation of this section, including rules:
- 11 (1) that establish criteria for expenditures that are
- 12 eligible for reimbursement;
- (2) for forms and procedures for application and
- 14 receipt requirements; and
- 15 (3) that set the maximum amount of money that may be
- 16 allocated from the fund for use as provided by this section.
- 17 (e) A reimbursement for expenses under this section is
- 18 contingent on the availability of money in the fund and subject to
- 19 the discretion of the governor.
- SECTION 3. Not later than December 1, 2017, the office of
- 21 the governor shall adopt rules necessary to implement Section
- 22 481.081, Government Code, as added by this Act.
- SECTION 4. Section 481.078(c), Government Code, as amended
- 24 by this Act, and Section 481.081, Government Code, as added by this
- 25 Act, apply only to a grant that is awarded on or after the effective
- 26 date of this Act. A grant that is awarded before the effective date
- 27 of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the grant

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- 1 was awarded, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 2 purpose.
- 3 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect January 1, 2018.
