- 2 relating to the time period for the withdrawal of a candidate for a

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 172.052(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) A candidate for nomination may not withdraw from the
- 8 general primary election after the third [first] day after the date
- 9 of the regular filing deadline for the general primary election.
- SECTION 2. Section 172.054(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 11 read as follows:
- 12 (a) The deadline for filing an application for a place on
- 13 the general primary election ballot is extended as provided by this
- 14 section if a candidate who has made an application that complies
- 15 with the applicable requirements:
- 16 (1) dies on or after the fifth day before the date of
- 17 the regular filing deadline and on or before the first day after the
- 18 date of the regular filing deadline;
- 19 (2) holds the office for which the application was
- 20 made and<u>:</u>
- 21 (A) withdraws on or before the third day after
- 22 the date of the regular filing deadline; or
- 23 (B) is declared ineligible on the date of the
- 24 regular filing deadline or the first day after the date of the

- 1 regular filing deadline; or
- 2 (3) withdraws or is declared ineligible during the
- 3 period prescribed by Subdivision (2)(A) or (B), as applicable
- 4  $\left[\frac{(2)}{(2)}\right]$ , and at the time of the withdrawal or declaration of
- 5 ineligibility no other candidate has made an application that
- 6 complies with the applicable requirements for the office sought by
- 7 the withdrawn or ineligible candidate.
- 8 SECTION 3. Section 172.057, Election Code, is amended to
- 9 read as follows:
- 10 Sec. 172.057. WITHDRAWN, DECEASED, OR INELIGIBLE
- 11 CANDIDATE'S NAME OMITTED FROM GENERAL PRIMARY BALLOT. A
- 12 candidate's name shall be omitted from the general primary election
- 13 ballot if the candidate  $[withdraws_T]$  dies[T] or is declared
- 14 ineligible on or before the first day after the date of the regular
- 15 filing deadline or withdraws on or before the third day after the
- 16 date of the regular filing deadline.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
