## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 551.001(4), Government Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (4) "Meeting" means:
- 8 (A) a deliberation between a quorum of a
- 9 governmental body, or between a quorum of a governmental body and
- 10 another person, during which public business or public policy over
- 11 which the governmental body has supervision or control is discussed
- 12 or considered or during which the governmental body takes formal
- 13 action; or
- 14 (B) except as otherwise provided by this
- 15 subdivision, a gathering:
- 16 (i) that is conducted by the governmental
- 17 body or for which the governmental body is responsible;
- 18 (ii) at which a quorum of members of the
- 19 governmental body is present;
- 20 (iii) that has been called by the
- 21 governmental body; and
- 22 (iv) at which the members receive
- 23 information from, give information to, ask questions of, or receive
- 24 questions from any third person, including an employee of the

- 1 governmental body, about the public business or public policy over
- 2 which the governmental body has supervision or control.
- 3 The term does not include the gathering of a quorum of a
- 4 governmental body at a social function unrelated to the public
- 5 business that is conducted by the body, [orderightarrow a] the attendance by a
- 6 quorum of a governmental body at a regional, state, or national
- 7 convention or workshop, ceremonial event, or press conference, or
- 8 the attendance by a quorum of a governmental body at a candidate
- 9 forum, appearance, or debate to inform the electorate, if formal
- 10 action is not taken and any discussion of public business is
- 11 incidental to the social function, convention, workshop,
- 12 ceremonial event, [or] press conference, forum, appearance, or
- 13 debate.
- 14 The term includes a session of a governmental body.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
