9	Sec. 766.101. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter, "fire
10	<pre>protection sprinkler system" and "residential high-rise building"</pre>
11	have the meanings assigned by Section 766.051.
12	Sec. 766.102. APPLICABILITY OF SUBCHAPTER. This subchapter
13	applies only to a municipality with a population of not less than
14	750,000 nor more than 850,000.
15	Sec. 766.103. REQUIREMENT FOR FIRE PROTECTION SPRINKLER
16	SYSTEM PROHIBITED FOR CERTAIN BUILDINGS. (a) Except as provided by
17	Subsection (b), a municipality may not adopt or enforce an
18	ordinance or other measure that requires the installation of a fire
19	protection sprinkler system in a residential high-rise building
