Section 161.080, Human Resources Code, 8 is 9 amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsections (c), (d), and (e) to read as follows: 10 11 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, a state supported living 12 center may provide nonresidential services to support an individual if[+ 13 14 [(1) the individual: 15 [(A) is receiving services in a program funded by 16 the department; 17 [(B) meets the eligibility criteria intermediate care facility for persons with an intellectual 18 19 disability program; and 20 [(C) resides in the area in which the 21 state supported living center is located; and 22 $\left[\frac{(2)}{(2)}\right]$ the provision of services to the individual does 23 not interfere with the provision of services to a resident of the

24 state supported living center.

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1	(c) The executive commissioner by rule shall establish:
2	(1) a list of services a state supported living center
3	may provide under a contract described by Subsection (a); and
4	(2) procedures for the commission to create, maintain,
5	and amend as needed a schedule of fees that a state supported living
6	center may charge for a service included in the list described by
7	Subdivision (1).
8	(d) In creating a schedule of fees, the commission shall:
9	(1) use the reimbursement rate for the applicable
10	service under the Medicaid program; or
11	(2) modify that rate with a written justification for

14	(e) Notwithstanding Subsection (c), a state supported
15	living center, based on negotiations between the center and a
16	managed care organization, as defined by Section 533.001,
17	Government Code, may charge a fee for a service other than the fee

20	SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2018, the executive
21	commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall
22	adopt the rules listing services a state supported living center
23	may provide under a contract and the procedures for the commission
24	to create the schedule of fees for those services, as required by
25	Section 161.080, Human Resources Code, as amended by this Act.
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26 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
