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- relating to the Texas natural gas vehicle grant program, including 2 the funding of fueling stations from grants under that program.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- SECTION 1. Section 394.010, Health and Safety Code, 5
- amended by amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (d-1) to 6
- read as follows: 7

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- A station [Stations] funded by a grant [grants] under 8
- 9 this section must be publicly accessible unless the station is:
- (1) owned or operated by a transit authority governed 10
- by Chapter 451 or 452, Transportation Code; and 11
- 12 (2) located in a county that has a population of more
- than one million. 13
- 14 (d-1) The commission shall give preference to:
- (1) stations providing both liquefied natural gas and 15
- compressed natural gas at a single location; 16
- stations located not more than one mile from an 17 (2)
- interstate highway system; and 18
- (3) stations located in the triangular area between 19
- the Houston, San Antonio, and Dallas-Fort Worth areas. 20
