- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1301.151(a), Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The Texas State Board of Plumbing Examiners consists of
- 8 nine members appointed by the governor with the advice and consent
- 9 of the senate as follows:
- 10 (1) one member who has at least 10 years' practical
- 11 experience and is licensed as a master plumber;
- 12 (2) one member who has at least five years' practical
- 13 experience and is licensed as a journeyman plumber;
- 14 (3) one member who has at least five years' practical
- 15 experience and is licensed as a master plumber or journeyman
- 16 plumber;
- 17 (4) one member who has at least five years' practical
- 18 experience and is licensed as a plumbing inspector;
- (5) $[\frac{(4)}{(4)}]$ one member who has been a responsible master
- 20 plumber for at least five years with at least 10 years' experience
- 21 as a licensed journeyman plumber or master plumber;
- 22 $\underline{(6)}$ [$\overline{(5)}$] one member who is a licensed engineer
- 23 practicing in the field of plumbing engineering;
- 24 (7) [(6)] two members who are building contractors

- 2 principally engaged in home building and one of whom is principally
- 3 engaged in commercial building; and
- 4 (8) one member who represents [(7) two members who
- 5 represent] the public.
- 6 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 7 1301.151, Occupations Code, regarding the composition of the Texas
- 8 State Board of Plumbing Examiners does not affect the entitlement
- 9 of a member serving on the board immediately before the effective
- 10 date of this Act to continue to serve as a member of the board for
- 11 the remainder of the member's term. As the terms of board members
- 12 who represent the public expire or as a vacancy occurs on the board
- 13 for a position held by a member who represents the public, the
- 14 governor shall appoint a member to the board as necessary to comply
- 15 with Section 1301.151, Occupations Code, as amended by this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
