2	relating to	holding	elections	on	uniform	election	dates.

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 41.253(b), Education Code, is amended to 5 read as follows:
- 6 (b) The transitional board of trustees shall divide the 7 consolidated district into nine single-member trustee districts in 8 accordance with the procedures provided by Section 11.052. The
- 9 transitional board shall order an election for the initial board of
- 10 trustees to be held on the first November [May] uniform election
- 11 date <u>in an even-numbered year</u> after the effective date of a
- 12 consolidation order.
- SECTION 2. Sections 41.001(a) and (b), Election Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 15 (a) Except as otherwise provided by this subchapter, each
- 16 general or special election in this state shall be held on [one of
- 17 the following dates:
- 18 [(1) the first Saturday in May in an odd-numbered
- 19 <del>year;</del>
- 20 [(2) the first Saturday in May in an even-numbered
- 21 year, for an election held by a political subdivision other than a
- 22 county; or
- [(3)] the first Tuesday after the first Monday in
- 24 November in an even-numbered year.

- 1 (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to:
- 2 (1) a runoff election;
- 3 (2) an election to resolve a tie vote;
- 4 (3) an election held under an order of a court or other
- 5 tribunal;
- 6 (4) an emergency election ordered under Section
- 7 41.0011;
- 8 (5) an expedited election to fill a vacancy in the
- 9 legislature held under Section 203.013;
- 10 [<del>(6)</del> an election held under a statute that expressly
- 11 provides that the requirement of Subsection (a) does not apply to
- 12 the election; or
- (6)  $\left[\frac{(7)}{(7)}\right]$  the initial election of the members of the
- 14 governing body of a newly incorporated city.
- 15 SECTION 3. Subchapter A, Chapter 41, Election Code, is
- 16 amended by adding Section 41.0051 to read as follows:
- Sec. 41.0051. ELECTION TO ISSUE BONDS. Notwithstanding any
- 18 other law, an election for the issuance of bonds by a political
- 19 subdivision shall be held on the uniform election date in an
- 20 even-numbered year.
- SECTION 4. Section 41.0052(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 22 read as follows:
- 23 (a) The governing body of a political subdivision[, other
- 24 than a county or municipal utility district, | that holds its
- 25 general election for officers on a date other than the November
- 26 uniform election date in an even-numbered year shall [may], not
- 27 later than December 31, 2017 [2016], change the date on which it

- 1 holds its general election for officers to the November uniform
- 2 election date in an even-numbered year in a manner that does not
- 3 cause an officer's term to exceed any applicable constitutional
- 4 limits.
- 5 SECTION 5. Section 43.007(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) The secretary of state shall implement a program to
- 8 allow each commissioners court participating in the program to
- 9 eliminate county election precinct polling places and establish
- 10 countywide polling places for:
- 11 (1) each general election for state and county
- 12 officers;
- 13 (2) [each election held on the uniform election date
- 14 in May;
- 15 [<del>(3)</del>] each election on a proposed constitutional
- 16 amendment;
- (3)  $\left[\frac{4}{4}\right]$  each primary election and runoff primary
- 18 election if:
- 19 (A) the county chair or county executive
- 20 committee of each political party participating in a joint primary
- 21 election under Section 172.126 agrees to the use of countywide
- 22 polling places; or
- 23 (B) the county chair or county executive
- 24 committee of each political party required to nominate candidates
- 25 by primary election agrees to use the same countywide polling
- 26 places; and
- (4)  $\left[\frac{(5)}{(5)}\right]$  each election of a political subdivision

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- 1 located in the county that is held jointly with an election
- 2 described by Subdivision (1), (2),  $\underline{\text{or}}$  (3)[ $\frac{}{}$ ,  $\underline{\text{or}}$  (4)].
- 3 SECTION 6. Section 67.003(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 4 read as follows:
- 5 (a) Except as provided by Subsection [<del>(b) or</del>] (c), each
- 6 local canvassing authority shall convene to conduct the local
- 7 canvass at the time set by the canvassing authority's presiding
- 8 officer not earlier than the eighth day or later than the 11th day
- 9 after election day.
- SECTION 7. Section 49.103(b), Water Code, is amended to
- 11 read as follows:
- 12 (b) After confirmation of a district, an election shall be
- 13 held on the uniform election date, provided by Section 41.001,
- 14 Election Code, [in May of each even-numbered year] to elect the
- 15 appropriate number of directors.
- SECTION 8. Section 56.804(a), Water Code, is amended to
- 17 read as follows:
- 18 (a) The election shall be held on the [a] uniform election
- 19 day [<u>in May</u>].
- 20 SECTION 9. The following laws are repealed:
- 21 (1) Section 11.0581, Education Code; and
- 22 (2) Sections 41.001(c) and(d), 41.0052(e), 41.007(d),
- 23 42.002(c), 67.003(b), and 85.001(e), Election Code.
- 24 SECTION 10. This Act applies only to an election ordered on
- 25 or after the effective date of this Act. An election ordered before
- 26 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law as it existed
- 27 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is

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- 1 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 2 SECTION 11. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
