(d) The commission shall adopt reasonable rules and 8 9 procedures establishing minimum standards regarding the continuity of prescription medications for the care and treatment of 10 prisoners. The rules and procedures shall require that a prisoner 11 12 who is determined to be lawfully taking a prescription medication when the prisoner enters the county jail be maintained on that same 13 14 prescription medication or an equivalent generic drug until a qualified health care professional directs otherwise on 15 individualized consideration. 16

SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2018, the Commission on Jail Standards shall adopt the rules and procedures required by Section 511.009(d), Government Code, as added by this Act.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
